Kosovo's small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) are entering a new era of growth and opportunity with the launch of the EEN KosInn (2025-2028) project. Officially started on 1 July 2025 under the European Union's SMP-COSME programme, this initiative marks the next chapter in the Enterprise Europe Network's (EEN) long-standing commitment to supporting Kosovar businesses. Over the next 42 months, EEN KosInn will act as a vital driver of innovation, digital transformation, tsustainability, and internationalisation-key factors that will boost the competitiveness of Kosovo's SMEs on the European and global stage.

Recognizing the diversity of Kosovo's business landscape, EEN Koslnn places special emphasis on SMEs in transition-innovative start-ups establishing their footing, women-led companies seeking expansion, and high-potential firms aiming to scale and internationalize. By targeting these groups, the project addresses critical challenges such as access to finance, market intelligence, and digital readiness, ensuring the support delivered has the greatest impact.

At the heart of **EEN KosInn's** offer is a comprehensive suite of tailored services designed to support SMEs at every stage of their development. Businesses will receive hands-on consultancy and strategic advice to optimise operations and prepare for growth. The project will also assist

companies in developing innovation strategies, fostering research collaborations, and scouting for emerging technologies. Moreover, **EEN KosInn** will facilitate partnerships between SMEs and research institutions or technology providers, accelerating the adoption of cutting-edge solutions. Support for internationalisation includes guidance on entering new markets, participation in matchmaking events, and building cross-border collaborations. All these efforts are backed by the Enterprise Europe Network, a global consortium of more than 600 partners across **60+ countries**, offering Kosovar SMEs unparalleled access to international opportunities ranging from brokerage events to collaborative ventures.

















A core focus of the project is to help SMEs embrace digitalisation and sustainability, two critical pillars of future business success. Companies will receive dedicated support to implement digital tools and platforms that enhance productivity and customer engagement. At the same time, EEN KosInn will guide enterprises in adopting sustainable business practices that reduce environmental impact and

improve energy efficiency. By connecting SMEs to expertise and funding for green innovation, the project helps them build resilience against economic and environmental challenges. This dual approach aligns Kosovo's businesses with broader European and global agendas addressing climate change and the digital economy.

## Kick-off Meeting: Setting the Stage for 2025-2028

On 18 July 2025, the EEN Koslnn consortium held its official kick-off meeting at the coordination premises in Prishtina, marking the operational start of the 2025-2028 project cycle. The meeting brought together all implementing teams to align priorities, finalise work packages, and set clear milestones for the coming 42 months.

The agenda focused on establishing internal governance structures and agreeing on quality assurance mechanisms to ensure smooth implementation. Dedicated sessions were held on the communication package, including branding, stakeholder engagement, and outreach channels, with an emphasis on providing SMEs with timely updates, success stories, and easy access to services.



A key milestone of the meeting was the signing of Consortium Agreements, reinforcing the partnership framework for the implementation period. Participants also reviewed and endorsed the Communication and Visibility Strategy, including branding and visual identity guidelines, to ensure a unified and impactful presence of the EEN KosInn project.

Participants reviewed the implementation roadmap, outlining key actions in innovation support, digitalisation, sustainability, and internationalisation-the core pillars of EEN Koslnn's mission. Special attention was given to strengthening collaboration among teams, sharing expertise, and optimising resources to deliver seamless support to SMEs.



















The meeting concluded with a commitment to ensuring that EEN Koslnn's services reach SMEs across all sectors, creating measurable impact through advisory services, cross-border partnerships, and innovation-driven growth initiatives. With a shared vision and coordinated approach, the consortium entered its new phase of activities ready to make EEN Koslnn a driving force for Kosovo's SME competitiveness.
